This art with a purpose project taught the kids that they can use their artistic talents to serve our community," said Dunn.

The 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Franklin Classic will be held on Labor Day, Mon., Sept. 1, 2008 in Historic Downtown Franklin.

As Middle Tennessee's oldest-running race, the Franklin Classic is a 10K and 5K certified and ChampionChip timed road race, a 4K Walk through scenic Historic Franklin and a 1K Kids Fun Run. Including runners, walkers and cheering crowds, more than 6,000 individuals participated in last year's Classic.
